Basic User instructions



Changing your safe code

(Default Manager code "123456". Safely store the new code and perform various opening / closing tests before closing the safe door).

To be performed with the door open!

- 1. Press and hold 0 until the double beep. The LED remains on.
- 2. Enter the old code. (Factory setting is 123456)
- 3. Enter the new code.
- 4. Confirm the new code.
- 5. Perform various opening / closing tests before closing the safe door.

Penalty

After four attempts to enter an incorrect code, the lock starts a 4-minute delay period. Each attempt to enter the code within the 4 minutes delay period restarts the count.

Battery

A long beep during opening indicates a low battery level. Replace immediately the low battery with a new Alkaline battery. Pull tab down to release the 9V battery.

Sound signals

A double beep normally indicates a correct operation. A long beep indicates an incorrect operation and the end of the operation itself.
